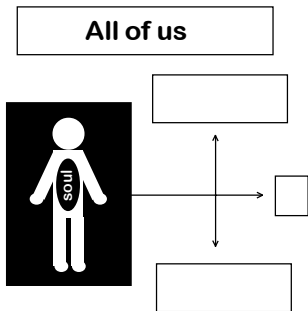

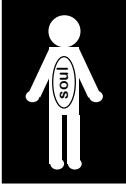

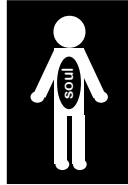
18. I have told a lie in my life - have you? So what does that make us? A liar, true? Can I ask you another question?
19. Have you ever taken anything that didn't belong to you like a paper clip, a ball point pen, made a phone call in your boss's time etc? If the answer is yes what does that make you? A thief, same as me.
20. Now do you think God is going to let thieving liars like us in Heaven? I don't think so.
21. Because if God doesn't punish us for breaking His laws, He would be the same as the unjust judge who failed to punish .....'S killer.
22. Now some people say 'wait a minute. There is a big difference between lying and thieving and murder!'
23. But for Jesus hate is the same as Murder. If we have hated someone in our hearts, we have murdered them in our hearts. I have hated someone in my life even just for a moment. Would you have done that? So in Gods sight, what does that make us? We are murderers as well.

**This is the bad news. For the sake of justice there has to be a Hell.

27. Second, He was making a way for us to be forgiven.

28. Thirdly, He was making a way for people to restore friendship with God.

## HOW TO FINISH OFF

**(Show Follow Up Booklet)** It's called 'How to be sure of going of going to Heaven at death', because a lot of people think that if they are good, they will automatically go to Heaven - like having a free ticket. It doesn't work like that.

**Section 1** covers what I have already shown you, with some extra illustrations. Read this so you totally understand.

**Section 2** shows you how to have that third major event. There are 4 attitudes here and three here. These attitudes are like a spiritual warrant of fitness. You know how your car has to pass a test to go on the road? Well this is what God says we need to do to make it to Heaven. If you agree with seven out of seven . . .

**(Section 3)** and pray through this prayer here, then if you are genuine, you can be absolutely certain that when you die you are going to heaven! Which is where God wants you and I want you.

**(Section 4)** This last section shows you "How your life would change if you became a Christian". What would happen to you? What would God do for you? It is also great for helping us understand who we are and why we do some of the things we do.

**(Back)** Here is my name at the back. If you have any questions or want to let me know what you think of the book, I would love to hear from you. There are also some great websites here that answer questions like "How do you know the Bible is true?", "What about all the other religions?" etc.

**(Ideas for finishing positively)** . . . Now was that OK? Was that helpful? What did you think of that? Have you got any questions? When I get to heaven, and if you're not there, I'm going to be really upset! I'm going to be praying for you. It has been great talking with you. Thank you for your time. Have an awesome day.

*You could use this story as an optional extra to reinforce the authority of God vs the opinions of man*

1. Now someone I know did this with a lady.
2. Her name was Mary. Mary was about 45.
3. Mary was shocked when she found out that she was going to hell.
4. She had always believed that by being just a good person, you get to heaven.
5. Well, as my friend was leaving, Mary got him by the arm and said, "Wait a minute. My friends told me that I'm a beautiful person and that when I die, I am going to go to heaven."
6. My friend said, "Mary, you are a beautiful person. You got a great score. But think of the warrant of fitness. When you take your car in, is it your friends who give you the warrant or the guy in the testing station?" See, in the end it doesn't matter what anyone else thinks - only what God thinks.

#### *Optional way of presenting final section*

This last section shows you how your life would change if you became a Christian. Now, remember the movie 'Braveheart' with Mel Gibson? In that movie, Mel Gibson says, "All men die but not all men live." There are a lot of people out there who are alive but they're not really living. Now I know something about you! You don't want to waste your life – right? These four pages tell you the secrets that Jesus gave to how you can really live ... how would your life change, what would happen to you, what would God do for you. It is also great for helping us to understand who we are and why we do what we do.



## **How to start with a person of another religion (i.e a Mormon, a JW, a Hindu, a Buddhist, Muslim etc)?**

Hey, are you a Muslim? {Yes}. I respect that. You and I have a lot in common. However, I expect that you and I are going to differ in our beliefs with what I am going to show you. I would appreciate it if you could help me anyway. I would like to take you through this and perhaps you could tell me where this varies from what you believe?

**Result:** After they have heard the gospel, they will usually confess they are going to hell, and you have not offended them by trying to argue them out of their religion. Once they have heard the gospel it is now up to the Holy Spirit to convict them of the truth eg according to Mohammad, they're going to heaven. According to Jesus Christ and the Bible, they are going to go to hell. In other words, would the real God please stand up?

## **How to end with a person of another religion**

The following example is a possible conversation with a Muslim:

**Christian:** "If you died tonight, where would you go?"

**Muslim:** "I still think that I am going to heaven"

**Christian:** "I know that according to the Koran, this is true. But where would you go if this, what I have shared with you today, was true?"

**Muslim:** 'Well, if this was true, I would go to hell'.

**Christian:** "I respect the fact that you are a Muslim. However, you and I disagree so much though that only one of us

can be right. Either Mohammed is right or Jesus is right. Why don't we put this to the test? Why don't you read this booklet, pray sincerely to Jesus and ask him if he is really there? If he is not there, you have lost nothing and your belief in the Koran will be confirmed. If Jesus is really there, you will have found the one true God. You have nothing to lose.
